ISP works with women who have been homeless or are in addiction recovery and who participate in a recovery program at a residential recovery home or transitional living home.

Denise, a member of the facilitation team, said "ever since Covid forced me to work from home and isolate from friends and family, I'm sensitive to too much time alone. I just returned from a retreat at Siena Retreat Center and never experienced pangs of loneliness. Time alone at Siena Retreat Center is time spent in a deep, loving presence. Being on my own in the loving presence so palpable at Siena is a comfort."

"Making retreat experiences accessible is a priority of the center, one that we work diligently to ensure," says Ben Brzeski, Director of Donor and Community Engagement. "We are fortunate to enjoy the generous support of many friends

and benefactors – that support has led to impact in a variety of ways this year."

In addition to growing our scholarship fund and keeping the fee structure accessible for groups like ISP, the Center's technology resources got a major boost through a grant from United Way of Racine County this year and a special gift from an individual donor of a 65" smart TV with portable cart, now available to our groups.

A new CRM (relationship management software) system has been acquired and implemented, improving online registration, constituent communication, staff efficiency, and data management.

Guest comfort is always top of mind, and the Center was able to replace a number of our pillows in the bedrooms this year.

"From building organizational capacity to the simple fact that lives are being transformed within these walls," says Brzeski, "it is just so gratifying to be able to so clearly see and demonstrate the impact our supporters are making every day!"



Siena Retreat Center responds to


the need for ongoing training, retreats, and community building among spiritual guides by adding offerings
