Staff Updates









Many communities, organizations, and circles of friends find Siena Retreat Center to be a welcoming setting for their own gatherings. In the past year, 2,253 participants joined us for **Hosted Retreats**, representing groups from church communities, meditation circles, nonprofits, religious communities, and many more. They discovered the spaciousness and inspiration of our lakeside environment. Whether coming together for reflection, planning, or creative exploration, groups are supported by our comfortable facilities, nourishing meals, and the quiet beauty of the shoreline.



The Siena Retreat Center **Bookstore** offers a carefully curated selection of resources to inspire reflection and renewal. Visitors discover books on spirituality, creativity, and social and ecological justice, along with fair-trade and handcrafted items such as weavings, singing bowls, cards, artwork and other gift items that extend the retreat experience and invite a spirit of mindfulness into daily life.



Private Retreats offer individuals the gift of quiet reflection, rest, and spiritual renewal. Each retreatant can shape their own experience through prayer, journaling, meditation, or contemplative walks along the Lake Michigan shoreline within a peaceful environment. These self-guided retreats provide a space to pause, listen, and deepen one's awareness of the Divine in everyday life. Many retreatants return again and again, finding that even a single day of solitude can spark lasting insight, renewed energy, and a sense of connection to the larger rhythm of life. This past year we welcomed 289 private retreatants to the center!



Sabbaticals offer an extended period of time for deep renewal, reflection, and spiritual growth. They are designed for individuals seeking to step away from daily responsibilities, discern life transitions, or engage more fully in creative, spiritual, or professional work. Participants follow a self-guided rhythm, combining prayer, study, writing, artistic practice, and contemplative exploration. Each sabbatical provides the time and space to listen more deeply, gain clarity, and return with renewed insight, purpose, and energy for their next chapter.



Spiritual Guidance provides one-on-one support for those seeking to deepen their awareness of the Divine in everyday life. Trained guides walk alongside retreatants, offering attentive listening, reflection, and encouragement. The Spiritual Guidance Training Program equips individuals to serve as guides themselves, combining instruction, practice, and mentorship. Each cohort explores the principles and practices of compassionate listening, discernment, and contemplative presence, preparing participants to offer this sacred ministry while continuing to grow in their own spiritual lives.





Sponsored Retreats offer guided programs on spirituality, creativity, social justice, and personal growth. Led by a skilled and diverse group of facilitators, these retreats provide experiences that encourage reflection, learning, and connection with others. Participants engage in workshops, discussion, prayer, and creative practices, exploring ideas that deepen awareness and foster meaningful change. These retreats foster community, insight, and inspiration, helping participants carry the lessons and renewal of the retreat into their daily lives.



<u>Sponsored Retreat Programs</u>

This year, Siena Retreat Center hosted over 100 sponsored retreats, welcoming 2,717 participants. Programs addressed a wide range of themes, including spirituality, social justice, creativity, interfaith traditions, and the challenges of living with integrity in our complex world. Retreats were offered in varied formats, from one-time conversations and daylong gatherings to multi-day retreats, making them accessible to people at many points along their spiritual journey.









Some retreats created space for reflection on everyday practices, like how a simple cup of coffee connects us to farmers, ecosystems, and global trade. Others drew from Indigenous wisdom, as participants learned from James Pete in *The Anishinaabe Approach to the Circle of Life* about cultural traditions, resilience, and healing for the next seven generations, and from Gerald Farinas in *The Healing Practice of Ho'oponopono*, a Hawaiian prayer of reconciliation and forgiveness. These experiences deepened awareness and appreciation of diverse spiritual traditions, inviting participants to walk more gently and reverently with creation and one another.

We also welcomed widely known voices in contemporary spirituality. In *Cosmic Spirituality in an Expanding Universe*, Dr. Brian Swimme explored the great unfolding story of the cosmos, while Mark Nepo's presentation, *The Power of Friendship*, invited retreatants to embrace kinship and the deep safety of connection. Together, these two programs drew well over one hundred participants, each discovering new ways of holding both awe and intimacy as spiritual practices in today's world.

Annual Spring Benefit Concert with Peter Mayer



Siena Retreat Center's Annual Spring Benefit Concert welcomed over 218 guests for a performance by folk singer and songwriter Peter Mayer. Best known for his song Blue Boat Home, Mayer has been described as "a philosopher, a theologian, a humorist, a poet, a wise man, and a minstrel." His music, rooted in wonder and attentive to the sacred in everyday life, offered the audience a rich blend of reflection and delight.

The event was also a great success, raising over \$18,000 to support our mission thanks to the generosity of donors, silent auction bidders, and our corporate sponsors (listed on page 14).

Launching our Self-Guided Sabbatical Experience

This year, Siena Retreat Center proudly launched our new self-guided Sabbatical space, offering individuals the gift of extended time for reflection, prayer, discernment, and creative work. A sabbatical is an extended retreat, typically from ten nights to twelve weeks, set aside for rest, renewal, and deeper listening. At Siena Retreat Center, sabbaticants shape their own rhythm of prayer, study, writing, walking in nature, or simple stillness, supported by weekly spiritual guidance. Sabbaticals are especially meaningful for those in life transitions, discerning new directions, completing creative projects, or seeking spiritual renewal. This new offering reflects our mission to be a sanctuary of peace and growth, meeting the needs of people in today's fast-paced, demanding world.

Our first sabbaticants came with a wide variety of hopes and intentions. Some sought clarity about next steps in their vocation, listening deeply for the spirit's guidance. Others arrived after seasons of change, in need of healing and a peaceful environment to restore balance. One sabbaticant wove prayer and reflection together with the writing of a new book, while another came after years of ministry leadership, seeking renewal for the journey ahead. Each discovered a rhythm of rest, reflection, and restoration uniquely their own. Their experiences affirm that sabbaticals provide more than rest, they offer space for profound personal transformation.

In our inaugural year, we welcomed our first 4 sabbaticants who stayed for a total of 123 nights with us at the center! We hope that each found in Siena Retreat Center a place of insight and new possibility. As word spreads, we look forward to expanding this program, continuing to offer self-guided sabbatical space as a vital expression of our ministry.




By the Numbers
